

Sunday Morning Sermon Series: "Ready or Not"





Little Praisers Christmas Program




(Mailings and Other Documents)

Grants

*Outreach, Submitted \$8,900, Awarded \$4,000 w/exclusions
Approved to fund 50% of the total cost of each line item excluding funding for food, bever ages, catering, rentals, mosquito repellent and transportation.

* Audio Visual, Phase 1, Submitted \$10,000, Pending Award 9/1/19

<u>Fellowship Fund</u> – This is a free will offering collected during our coffee and donut meet and greet held each Sunday from 10-10:25 a.m. This fund helps to offset the cost of coffee, creamers, sugars, donuts, paper products, etc.

<u>Flower Donations Being Accepted</u> – Our altar flowers are purchased each week from Armstrong Flowers and the expense is sometimes offset through donations from our congregation. If you (or someone close to you) have a special event and you would like to recognize this special day during our weekly service, please consider donating \$16 towards our flower fund. There is a clipboard/sign up sheet located in the back of Fellowship Hall to note the specifics as well as envelopes you can put your check or cash in and put it with your offering. After the service, please take your flowers home with you and enjoy their beauty with your loved one.

Contribution deficit increased from \$2,437 in April to \$2,725 short of YTD budget forecast. Fellowship deficit increased from \$40 in April to \$112 short of YTD budget forecast. Flowers deficit raised from \$64 in April to \$147 short of YTD budget forecast.

<u>On-line Giving:</u> Using on-line giving can benefit Praise as well as make giving easier for you. As you can see above, our church contributions fluctuate throughout the year which can create a challenge for our operations.

One way to reduce the "highs and lows" is to use on-line giving and set up automatic donations. This is perfect for those who:

- * Pay bills on-line normally

Thrivent Choice Dollars:

If you have a policy with Thrivent, you may also have Choice Dollars available for donation. February is a great month to log in and donate your 2018-accrued Choice Dollars to Praise Lutheran Church! Based on the Thrivent Choice FAQ, a member can only designate whether it is given to either our church or Little Praisers' organization (not to a specific project). Choice Dollars are a "use or lose" benefit with Thrivent and if the 2018 Choice Dollars are not donated by March 31, 2019, they will go back into Thrivent's account. So, don't lose out on this free benefit from Thrivent.

Thrivent Action Grants:

If you have a policy or investment with Thrivent, there is a good chance you also are eligible to obtain up to two \$250 action grants per calendar year! This is "free" money available to help with a wide variety of projects Praise ministries undertake. They take about 10 minutes to complete on line and within a few days, if approved, a \$250 Visa card will be sent to help fund worthwhile projects. Every event, every dinner, every fundraiser, every ministry activity should be submitting grant requests. Below is a form that shows the information needed.

Please fill out the attached form for any grants your ministry needs. If you want to submit the grant, or can find someone to do it, that's fabulous. Trish Niebuhr keeps track of them, so just shoot her an email if you submit a grant.

Grants MUST be submitted at least 17 days in advance. It takes time to find someone to do the grant and then get the information to them. If we are going to find someone to submit the grant, we REALLY need 3 weeks (21 days) at minimum.

We praise God for these financial gifts that are being made available to us through our friends at Thrivent! It is a blessing to be able to use Action Team Grants for our events!
