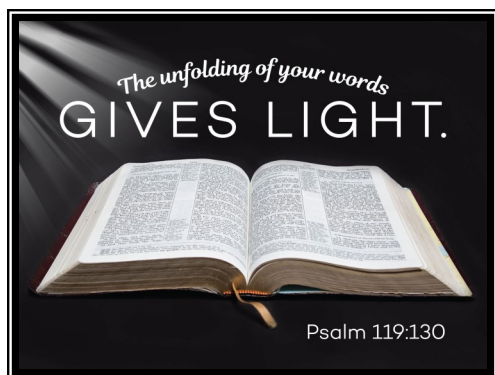

“An 8-Second Decision”

A new person (and some long-time attenders, too) makes a decision about our church **in just 8 seconds**. **You have just 8 seconds** to make a good first impression. **The first 8 seconds** is the appearance of the parking lot, lawn, front doors – **everything outside is “judged” in just 8 seconds**. **There is another 8 seconds** just inside the front doors – smells, greeters, welcoming feel – **all determined in just 8 seconds**. **Another 8 seconds** as the new attender enters the sanctuary – temperature, help in finding a seat, greeted by people sitting around them. We could also mention **the first 8 seconds** when a new family enters the nursery, children’s department, or the teen enters the teen room or **even the first 8 seconds** in the bathrooms. **We all make decision in just 8 seconds**.

The bottom line is this – **if the new attender has just three 8-second negative first impressions**, it will make no difference how good the music is or how good the message, they will probably not make Praise their home church. **The three 8-second negative impressions** can be neutralized, if the people sitting around them in the sanctuary, greet them in just 30 seconds after the service is over. Often times, after the service, regular attenders go toward the people they already know and not toward the new people.

Notice, **we mention the greeting after the service**, only neutralizes the **three negative 8-second experiences**. It does not turn the negatives into a positive. **But**, the new attender will possibly attend again to see if he next time there are more positives than negatives.

All of that is to say – **“thank you”** for greeting everyone you do not know. **Your smile, greeting, and welcome could change someone’s eternity in just 8 seconds**.

Grants

- *Outreach, Submitted \$8,900, Awarded \$4,000 w/exclusions
Approved to fund 50% of the total cost of each line item excluding funding for food, beverages, catering, rentals, mosquito repellent and transportation.
- * Audio Visual, Phase 1, Submitted \$10,000, Pending Award 9/1/19
- *Stained Glass, Submitted \$?, Pending Award 9/1/19

Fellowship Fund – This is a free will offering collected during our coffee and donut meet and greet held each Sunday from 10-10:25 a.m. This fund helps to offset the cost of coffee, creamers, sugars, donuts, paper products, etc.

Flower Donations Being Accepted – Our altar flowers are purchased each week from Armstrong Flowers and the expense is sometimes offset through donations from our congregation. If you (or someone close to you) have a special event and you would like to recognize this special day during our weekly service, please consider donating \$16 towards our flower fund. There is a clipboard/sign up sheet located in the back of Fellowship Hall to note the specifics as well as envelopes you can put your check or cash in and put it with your offering. After the service, please take your flowers home with you and enjoy their beauty with your loved one.

There is also an extra rehearsal the second Sunday of each month after worship. (July 14)



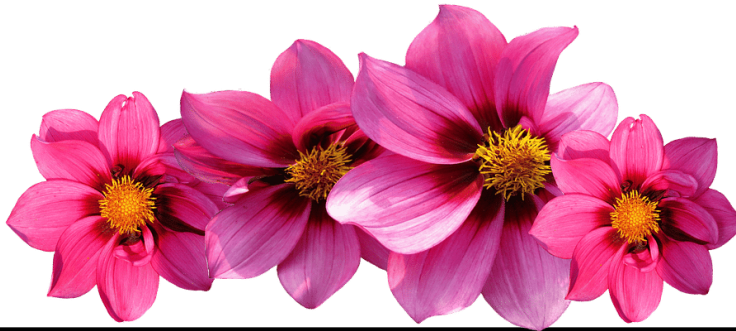

Thrivent Choice Dollars:



If you have a policy with Thrivent, you may also have Choice Dollars available for donation. February is a great month to log in and donate your 2018-accrued Choice Dollars to Praise Lutheran Church! Based on the Thrivent Choice FAQ, a member can only designate whether it is given to either our church or Little Praisers' organization (not to a specific project). Choice Dollars are a "use or lose" benefit with Thrivent and if the 2018 Choice Dollars are not donated by March 31, 2019, they will go back into Thrivent's account. So, don't lose out on this free benefit from Thrivent.

Thrivent Action Grants:

If you have a policy or investment with Thrivent, there is a good chance you also are eligible to obtain up to two \$250 action grants per calendar year! This is "free" money available to help with a wide variety of projects Praise ministries undertake. They take about 10 minutes to complete on line and within a few days, if approved, a \$250 Visa card will be sent to help fund worthwhile projects. Grants MUST be submitted at least 17 days in advance. It takes time to find someone to do the grant and then get the information to them. If I am going to find someone to submit the grant, I REALLY need 3 weeks (21 days) at minimum.
