


#### From the Pastor's Desk




♦ How would your spouse answer the questions above for you? How would your kids answer them for you? And your Co-workers? Your Friends? Neighbors? Fellow Church Members?



<u>Thrivent Choice Dollars:</u> If you have a policy with Thrivent, you may also have Choice Dollars available for donation. Based on the Thrivent Choice FAQ, a member can only designate whether it is given to either our church or Little Praisers' organization (not to a specific project). Choice Dollars are a "use or lose" benefit with Thrivent, if they are note used they will go back into Thrivent's account. So, don't lose out on this free benefit from Thrivent. **Do not forget, March is the final month to claim these choice dollars!** 

Thrivent Action Grants: If you have a policy or investment with Thrivent, there is a good chance you also are eligible to obtain up to two \$250 action grants per calendar year! This is "free" money available to help with a wide variety of projects Praise ministries undertake. They take about 10 minutes to complete on line and within a few days, if approved, a \$250 Visa card will be sent to help fund worthwhile projects. Every event, every dinner, every fundraiser, every ministry activity should be submitting grant requests. Below is a form that shows the information needed.
