

Our new window is a representation of the Trinity; with the hand of God coming into the center, flanked on each side by the dove (Holy Spirit) and the lamb (Son of God). You may also note the yellow triangle connecting the Trinity as well as the Bible at the bottom. Thrivent Choice Dollars: If you have a policy with Thrivent, you may also have Choice Dollars available for donation. Based on the Thrivent Choice FAQ, a member can only designate whether it is given to either our church or Little Praisers' organization (not to a specific project). Choice Dollars are a "use or lose" benefit with Thrivent , if they are not used they will go back into Thrivent's account. So, don't lose out on this free benefit from Thrivent.

<u>Thrivent Action Grants</u>: If you have a policy or investment with Thrivent, there is a good chance you also are eligible to obtain up to two \$250 action grants per calendar year! This is "free" money available to help with a wide variety of projects Praise ministries undertake. They take about 10 minutes to complete on line and within a few days, if approved, a \$250 Visa card will be sent to help fund worthwhile projects. Every event, every dinner, every fundraiser, every ministry activity should be submitting grant requests. Below is a form that shows the information needed.
