





3. How important is *availability* in God's Kingdom? What highlights of availability did we discover in Judges 4 and 5 through today's video?
4. Another topic we touched upon is *obedience*. How important is obedience in God's Kingdom? How did we see simple obedience (or lack thereof) play out today for the following:
 - a. Deborah
 - b. Barak

Personal Application Point: what does obedience to God's leading look like in your life?

5. What results from our obedience to God's Word? And our disobedience?
6. God shows us that He is in complete control at all times and is even able to use our misguided motivations towards His holy plans. Scripturally-speaking, what examples of this do we have?

Examples:

7. Perhaps we find that we are sometimes like Barak who wanted *assurance* before he would move with simple obedience. Does that describe you at this time?
 - a. What word of encouragement do we hear in Hebrews 11 (esp. verses 1-2)?
 - b. Where is God asking for your simple obedience at this time, especially when it comes to serving your congregation even if you don't see everything yet?
